Sir/Madam,

With reference to above, I am directed to inform that the recognition of Nehru Park Zoo, Danakgre,Tura, Akhongini Tura, Meghalaya was accorded up to August 19th, 2021 vide reference no. 3 above. The application for the renewal of recognition of Nehru Park Zoo, Danakgre,Tura, Akhongini Tura, Meghalaya for the period beyond August 19th, 2021 was received by this office vide reference no. 2 above.

Dr. Sudarshan Panda, IFS (Retd.) was deputed by this office to carry out the evaluation of Nehru Park Zoo, Danakgre,Tura, Akhongini Tura, Meghalaya vide CZA letter at reference no. 1 above. The Zoo was accordingly evaluated on June 8th, 2022.

The evaluation report (copy enclosed) as submitted by the evaluation officer was deliberated in the 106th meeting of the Technical Committee of the Central Zoo Authority held on September 27th, 2022. The Technical Committee after detailed deliberations recommended to the Central Zoo Authority for the renewal of recognition of Nehru Park Zoo, Danakgre,Tura, Akhongini Tura, Meghalaya for a period of one year and to regularise the period after August 19th, 2021, subject to compliance with observation/ recommendation in the table below and mid-term evaluation. The members also recommended that the Zoo Operator may be directed to submit half-yearly compliance report with respect to

observation/ recommendation stipulated while renewal of recognition.

Subsequently, the recommendation of 106th Technical Committee Meeting was approved by the Chairperson, Central Zoo Authority. Accordingly, the Central Zoo Authority has regularised the period after August 19th, 2021 and renewed the recognition of Nehru Park Zoo, Danakgre, Tura, Akhongini Tura, Meghalaya for a period up to December 7th, 2023 under Section 38-H(1), (3) & (4) of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972. This is subject to the ratification of this decision in the next meeting of the Central Zoo Authority.

15.		The present zoo site is not conducive for various animal spp. as it is located inside the forest with a crown density above 0.6 (Six).	
16.		The size of almost all the enclosures is not as per the prescriptions of the CZA & hence needs to be urgently demolished & reconstructed as per the Master Plan of the zoo.	
17.		Various enclosures are situated in different hill slopes having a slope degree of more than 30 & hence needs to be relocated to the upper ridges, as adequate space is available for the purpose.	
18.		The zoo is being managed with the hard work of present RFO who is also in-charge of the Protection Range of the Division without and assistance of Foresters & Forest guards except for some malis and casual employees.	
19.		The common fox which is housed in a small enclosure should be shifted to a larger vacant enclosure which is available at the zoo.	

A compliance report to the Central Zoo Authority on implementation of the aforesaid observation/ recommendation shall be submitted by the zoo within three months of issue of this letter. Further, half yearly report regarding progress made in the implementation of the aforesaid conditions should also be submitted to the Central Zoo Authority.

The recognition of Nehru Park Zoo, Danakgre, Tura, Akhongini Tura, Meghalaya for the period beyond December 6th, 2023 would be considered on the basis of compliance of the conditions stated above, mid-term evaluation and general performance of the zoo.

The recognition of Nehru Park Zoo, Danakgre, Tura, Akhongini Tura, Meghalaya shall be revoked by the Central Zoo Authority, at any point of time, if the zoo operator is found not complying with the stipulated conditions.

This issues with the approval of the competent authority.

Reference is invited to above cited correspondence. It is to inform that the evaluation of the Nehru Park, Tura, Meghalaya was carried out by Dr. Brij Kishor Gupta, Evaluation and Monitoring Officer, CZA on 11.06.2017. The evaluation report of the Nehru Park, Tura as submitted by the evaluating officer was considered by the Technical Committee in its 84th Meeting held on 19.09.2017. After detailed deliberations, the Technical Committee has recommended to the Central Zoo Authority for renewal of recognition of the Nehru Park, Tura, Meghalaya for a period of three years.

The Central Zoo Authority in its 30th Meeting held on 28.09.2017, approved the recommendation of the Technical Committee and has decided to renew recognition to the Nehru Park, Tura for a period of three years. Further, the Authority has also decided to regularise the period after 30.09.2016.

The renewal of recognition to the Nehru Park, Tura as "a Small Category Zoo" as per the provisions of Section 38H(1) of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 is for a period up to 27th September, 2020 subject to the compliance of the following directives under the Recognition of Zoo Rules, 2009 and mid-term evaluation of the zoo:-

At the time of evaluation the register was having details entered for the period upto July, 2017, and there have been animals rescued afterwards and housed by the Zoo without making any entry in the records. There was 2 Leopard cats at the Zoo. No approval from Chief Wildlife Warden of the State and the Central Zoo Authority was obtained for the same. The zoo operator is directed to obtain prior approval from the CWLW of the State and to maintain the records on day to day basis.	With immediate effect.

A half yearly report regarding progress made in implementation of the aforesaid conditions should be submitted to the Central Zoo Authority.

The renewal of recognition to the Nehru Park, Tura for period beyond 27th September, 2020 as "a Small Category Zoo" would be considered on the basis of compliance of the conditions stated above and general performance of the zoo.

The recognition to the Nehru Park, Tura shall be revoked by the Central Zoo Authority, at any point of time if the Zoo Operator is found not complying with the stipulated conditions.

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

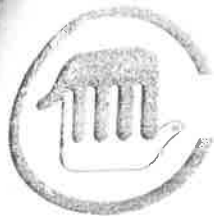

A half yearly report regarding progress made in implementation of the aforesaid conditions should be submitted to the Central Zoo Authority.

Grant of recognition beyond 28th February, 2011 to the Nehru Park Zoo, Tura as a 'mini category zoo' would be considered on the basis of compliance of the conditions stated above, general performance and physical evaluation of the zoo.

The recognition to the Nehru Park Zoo, Tura shall be revoked by the Central Zoo Authority, at any point in time if the Zoo Operator is found not complying with the stipulated conditions.
