Sir/Madam,

With the reference to above, it is to inform that recognition of the Lion Safari, Vasona, Dadra & Nagar Haveli under section 38-H of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 was valid till December 22, 2024. Application for renewal of recognition of the Lion Safari, Vasona, Dadra & Nagar Haveli beyond December 22, 2024 was received from Shri Joju P. Alappatt, IFS, Dy.C.F. (Wildlife), Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Silvassa on 13/12/2024 and Shri. Nitin H Kakodkar, IFS (Retd.), deputed by this office has evaluated the zoo on 30/10/2025. Copy of the Evaluation Report is enclosed herewith for your perusal and needful action.

2. Evaluation Report of the Lion Safari, Vasona, Dadra & Nagar Haveli was placed before the Technical Committee in its 117th Meeting of the Technical Committee held on January 16, 2026. The Technical Committee Upon deliberation on evaluation report submitted, has recommended to the Central Zoo Authority to renew recognition of the zoos and Subsequently, the Central Zoo Authority in its 43rd Meeting held on February 03, 2026 upon deliberation, approved recommendation of its Technical Committee.

3. As per provisions of sub-section (1), (3) and (4) of Section 38-H under the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972, regularized the period after December 22, 2024 and renewed recognition of the Lion Safari, Vasona, Dadra & Nagar Haveli as a **Mini Category Zoo** for a period up to **February 03, 2029** subject to compliance with the following conditions as per the Recognition of Zoo Rules, 2009 (RZR) and mid-term evaluation of the zoo.

A half-yearly compliance report to the Central Zoo Authority on implementation of the aforesaid conditions shall be submitted by the zoo.

5. The Lion Safari, Vasona, Dadra & Nagar Haveli shall comply with such standards and norms as are or may be specified or imposed, by or under the provisions of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 or the rules made thereunder; and the zoo operator shall comply with the directions and guidelines issued by the Central Zoo Authority from time to time, for the purpose of maintenance and upkeep of the Zoo.

6. The renewal of recognition of the Lion Safari, Vasona, Dadra & Nagar Haveli for period beyond February 03, 2029 would be considered on the basis of compliance of the conditions stated above and general performance of the zoo.

7. The recognition of the Lion Safari, Vasona, Dadra & Nagar Haveli shall be revoked by the Central Zoo Authority at any point of time if the Zoo Operator is found not complying with the stipulated conditions.

This is for your information and appropriate action.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to above, I am directed to inform that the recognition of Lion safari, Vasona, Dadra & Nagar Haveli was accorded up to August 19th, 2021 vide reference no. 3 above. The application for the renewal of recognition of Lion safari, Vasona, Dadra & Nagar Haveli for the period beyond August 19th, 2021 was received by this office vide reference no. 2 above.

Dr. Rashmi Kant Shukla, IFS (Retd.) was deputed by this office to carry out the evaluation of Lion safari, Vasona, Dadra & Nagar Haveli vide CZA letter at reference no. 1 above. The Zoo was accordingly evaluated on September 14-17, 2022.

The evaluation report (copy enclosed) as submitted by the evaluation officer was deliberated in the 106th meeting of the Technical Committee of the Central Zoo Authority held on September 27th, 2022. The Technical Committee after detailed deliberations recommended to the Central Zoo Authority for the renewal of recognition of Lion safari, Vasona, Dadra & Nagar Haveli for a period of two years and to regularise the period after August 19th, 2021, subject to

compliance with observation/ recommendation in the table below and mid-term evaluation. The members also recommended that the Zoo Operator may be directed to submit half-yearly compliance report with respect to observation/ recommendation stipulated while renewal of recognition.

Subsequently, the recommendation of 106th Technical Committee Meeting was approved by the Chairperson, Central Zoo Authority. Accordingly, the Central Zoo Authority has regularised the period after August 19th, 2021 and renewed the recognition of Lion safari, Vasona, Dadra & Nagar Haveli for a period up to December 22, 2024 under Section 38-H(1), (3) & (4) of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972. This is subject to the ratification of this decision in the next meeting of the Central Zoo Authority.



The Technical Committee of the Central Zoo Authority has decided to grant renewal of recognition to Lion Safari, Vasona, Dadra and Nagar Haveli as a "Mini Category Zoo" under Section 38H of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, for a period up to 23.08.2019 subject to the compliance of the following directives under the Recognition of Zoo Rules, 2009 and mid-term evaluation of the zoo:-

Other recommendations:-

1. The suitable tranquilizing equipment required to be used for remote drug delivery system should be made available. The existing tranquilizing equipments should get serviced to make it fully functional for the use.
2. Treatment records and animal history cards should be maintained as per the CZA format.
3. Stool examination of animals should be done periodically to check the parasitic load.
4. Vaccination of animal has not done since the year 2007. The Safari should prepare the vaccination protocol and implement the same regularly.

5. The staff involved in the upkeep and healthcare of animals should be screened against the zoonotic diseases once in a year.
6. The keepers diary should be maintained as per the CZA format.
7. The animal houses should be painted with camouflaging colour with the nature.
8. The stones inside the Safari Park should not be painted with white colour, it should be replaced with olive green colour.
9. The Safari Park should make the provision of stand by vehicle in case the running vehicle inside park becomes non functional.
10. The animal inventory register should be maintained as per the CZA's format.
11. The feeding and retiring cell should have the direct opening to the paddock area.
12. The gap at the iron grill of the window of Safari vehicle should be rectified to assure the visitor and animal safety.

A half yearly report regarding progress made in implementation of the aforesaid conditions should be submitted to the Central Zoo Authority.

Grant of recognition to Lion Safari, Vasona, Dadra and Nagar Haveli, Silvassa beyond 31.01.2015 as "a Mini Category Zoo" would be considered on the basis of compliance of the conditions stated above and general performance of the zoo.

The recognition to the Lion Safari, Vasona, Dadra and Nagar Haveli, Silvassa shall be revoked by the Central Zoo Authority, at any point of time if the Zoo Operator is found not complying with the stipulated conditions.
